ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The University of WI Oshkosh is conducting a groundwater study in Door County. The goal of this study is to provide education about the importance of testing your well water as well as build a database of groundwater quality data in Door County.

TESTING PARAMETERS IN STUDY

-  Total coliforms/*E. coli* (quantification)
-  Nitrate (Nitrate + nitrite as N)

Well owner cost is \$30*

**Discounted rate for the first 250 registrants; \$45 for those registering after the first 250 registrants.*

Optional arsenic, pH, alkalinity, hardness and iron tests available at an additional cost of \$25

- Return your kit October 8th or 9th at designated drop-off locations
- Receive your results & countywide summary of study
