

Town of Jacksonport

Resolution 04_2021 of Town Board to Propose Exceeding Levy Limits

Whereas, the State of Wisconsin has adopted levy limits on town, village, city and county levies for 2021 and thereafter under s. 66.0602 of Wis. Statutes;

Whereas, s. 66.0602 of Wis. Statutes limits the allowable local levy for 2021 to a percentage increase of no more than the greater of (a) 0% of the 2021 payable 2022 adjusted actual levy as calculated under the state's levy limit law** or (b) a percentage equal to the percent change in equalized value due to net new construction; which for the Town of Jacksonport is .772 percent;

Whereas, the Town Board of the Town of Jacksonport, Door County believes that for the 2021 tax levy (collected in 2022) it is in the town's best interest to exceed the state levy limit as described above by a greater percentage than 0.772%.

Whereas, the Town of Jacksonport 2021 payable 2022 adjusted actual levy is \$454,781; And further whereas the state law would limit the increase to \$3,511 (net new construction) for an allowable town tax levy of \$457,540 before adjustments, \$467,594 after adjustments for 2021, collected in 2022.

Now Therefore the Town Board of the Town of Jacksonport, Door County does hereby resolve and order as follows:

1. The town board supports an increase in the town tax levy for 2021 that will exceed the state levy limit.

2. The town board directs that the question of increasing the town tax levy for 2021 (to be collected in 2022) by 42.772 percent which would increase the town levy by \$200,000 for a total town tax levy of \$667,594, before adjustments and does not include personal property aid, shall be placed on the agenda for the special town meeting to be held on November 16, 2021
