Hours of Operation

The Town of Jacksonport parks are open to the public during hours posted at each park site.

Water/Beach Activities & Swimming

Enjoy water/beach activities & swimming at your own risk. There are no lifeguards at Town of Jacksonport parks. Glass containers are prohibited on town beaches.

Park Shelters

Shelters for gatherings and picnics are open to all on a first-come basis unless reserved in advance. Please contact the Town Clerk at jtownclerk@jportfd.com or 920-823-8136 to make a reservation.

Parking for Large Scale Vehicles/Trailers

Users of Lakeside Park with large scale vehicles/trailers (boat trailers, mobile homes, etc.) must park their vehicles/trailers at the designated area in the Jacksonport Town Hall parking lot at 3365 County V, slightly west of Lakeside Park, west of State Highway 57.

Pets

All pets must remain leashed, under the control of its master, and cleaned up after, while in town parks.

<u>Glass</u>

Glass containers are not allowed in the park. No beverages in glass containers may be sold in the park

Trash Disposal

Those who use the town parks are responsible for their trash disposal. The dumpsters within town parks are for park-use-associated trash disposal only; it is unlawful for anyone to bring trash to town parks and dispose of that trash within any town dumpster.

<u>Commercial Enterprises</u>

No commercial enterprises (venders, tour operators, equipment renters, advertisers, etc.) will be allowed in parks without Town Board approval.
